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Museums & Heritage Sites in Valletta

ST. JOHN'S CO-CATHEDRAL AND MUSEUM

St. John's Co-Cathedral, formerly the Conventual Church of the Order of St John, is historically and artistically one of the most important monuments on the island. It was built between 1573 and 1577 to the design of Gerolamo Cassar, chief engineer of the Order. The "Beheading of St. John", Caravaggio's masterpiece, hangs in the Oratory. Inside the Cathedral is a hymn of light and colour to the glory of the 'Monks in Armour' and their patron Saint John. Scenes from the life of the Saint are depicted by the famous artist

Mattia Preti along the whole length of the ceiling. The side chapels serving the various langue into which the Order was divided are of magnificent artistry. In the crypt there are buried the Grand Masters of the Order who died before St. John's was built. The museum houses a unique collection of Flemish tapestries, silver objects and church vestments.

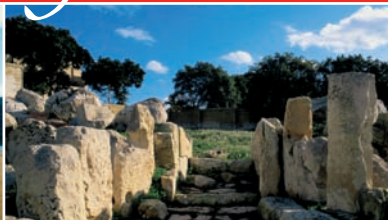
