#### **Public Transport**

Malta's public transport system offers a cheap and efficient way of touring the Island. The main bus terminus is in Valletta from where buses operate to all parts of Malta, although there are also direct, point to point, services. The cost of a bus route ranges from 47 to 57 euro cents. The longest bus journey takes about fifty minutes; the average ride is between 20 and 30 minutes.

Driving is on the left. There is a speed limit of 80kms per hour on arterial roads and 40kph in urban areas.

#### In Guardia

A historical re-enactment that portrays an authentic historical event. This is the regular inspection ofthe fort and garrison by the Grand Bailiff of the Order of the Knights of St. John in charge of military affairs. During the re-enactment the fort's garrison (some 70 in all) is dressed in its best uniforms to demonstrates to the Grand Bailiff its military prowess. #### **ALARME**

The 50 minute re-enactment portrays military skirmishes between Maltese militia and Napoleon's troops aided by a narration that describes the historical background of 1798 - 1800. The re-enactment unfolds in a series of dramatized scenes that depict the arrival of the French, their administration of Malta, the Maltese' rebellion and the arrival of the British Troops that led to the French surrender. The re-enactments are held according to schedule, however, in case of inclement weather or else due to some unforeseen circumstance the event may be cancelled without undue notice. 

#### Carmelite Church and Priory - Mdina

Set in a 17th century Baroque building the Carmelite Church and Priory has undergone important and significant restoration, to finally open its doors to the viewing public. This hidden gem, offers the public an opportunity to explore the way and life of the cloistered Carmelite friars in the 17th century. Hal Saflieni Hypogeum

This UNESCO World Heritage monument consists of halls, chambers and passages cut in rock. The complex is grouped in 3 levels dating from different periods, the deepest room being 10.6m under road surface.

#### **Malta Maritime Museum**

A former British Naval Bakery, the museum shows Malta's maritime history within a Mediterranean context. It also illustrates the global nature of seafaring and its impact on society.

#### **Ghar Dalam Cave & Museum**

The site is the earliest evidence of human settlement on Malta round 7,400 years ago. The cave was formed by an overlaying river making it become 144m deep. Only the first 50m are open to visitors.



**National Museum of Natural History** 

The 18th century Magisterial Palace of Justice currently holds over 10,000 rocks and minerals, over 3,500 birds, eggs and nests, 200 mammals, over 200 fish species and thousands shells and insects. A must for nature & history lovers.

#### The Mdina Dungeons

In a series of secret underground passageways, chambers and cells, a number of events have been re-created to portray historic events from the dark and turbulent side of Maltese history.



#### Palazzo Costanzo Medieval Times

An elegant Baroque palace built in the 17th Century offering a medieval adventure using wax figures, light, sound and smell. The history starts from the 14th and 15th century and depicts family life and Maltese trades.

#### **National Museum of Archaeology**

Previously known as Auberge de Provence, built after the Great Siege in the late 16th century, the museum contains a number of arte-facts from the prehistoric periods.
